HOW TO REQUEST A PUBLIC RECORD PURSUANT TO THE ILLINOIS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

Any person or entity requesting a public record from the Village must submit a written request either by mail or facsimile. Every requester is encouraged, but not required, to use the Village's FOIA form when submitting a FOIA request. Each person or entity requesting a public record should clearly state and describe the record in enough detail so that an employee can locate the record. Requests will be responded to within five (5) business days.

ALLOWABLE FEES UNDER THE FOIA (5 ILCS 140/6)

In certain circumstances, public entities may charge a fee for the production of public records. Some common examples include:

- * After the first 50 pages, black and white letter or legal sized copies shall be \$0.15 per page.
- * Color copies or copies in a size other than letter or legal shall be no more than the actual cost of reproducing the requested records.
- * Electronic copies requested on a disc shall be the actual cost of purchasing the recording medium.
- * Records requiring certification shall be at a cost reasonably calculated to reimburse the Village for its actual cost of reproducing and certifying the requested record.
