2. REPORT OF VILLAGE SERVICES DIRECTOR

Reported on the new way of processing P.O.'s, working on the budget, the bids for the Water Tank and Stockpile Removal will be opened tomorrow.

We will need to have a special Committee meeting next Tuesday for the Budget Appointments and Salaries. The Kid Zone at the Thunderbolts Stadium is being worked on. The street sweeper needs repair. Quotes are in on the 2 Interceptors. Talking to Palos Heights about buying 2 used Tahoes from them for \$24,000.00.

The Mayor talked about the State Police building on Cicero Ave. Dean Vallas has provided a free bus to the Breast Cancer Walk in Beverly on Sunday. There is a movie in the park on July 3rd, with fireworks to follow, bringing in your own food, drink and chairs is allowed.
