Goal of Crestwood T-Ball: To teach the fundamentals of baseball/softball in a relaxed, friendly environment. To let the players enjoy playing the game and to have fun doing it so that they will want to continue playing for many years. And to help prepare the children to associate and play well with others.

Games last Approximately 75 minutes normally 3-4 innings

Games are played as normal games, positions are taught

We use a cloth ball. Players can hit singles, doubles, triples and even an occasional homer, base coaches help the child to how far they can advance depending on how well they hit the ball and how they run. And just as good hitting is rewarded, so is good fielding, players can make outs. Coaches in the field help the players but don't assist in plays. Number of batters per inning is limited. Players hit off a batting T so they can develop and concentrate on a good swing. ***No Aluminum Bats, the ball reacts too quickly for the young players.***
