There is interest in the property behind Walgreens, and a possible big restaurant on Cicero. Fourteen new businesses are coming in to the Village.

Mid America wants an agreement with the Village to be the developer on the west side of the Route 83 property. Valley View bought the property across from Public Works

and is expanding. There is talk with Oremus about a possible dome. Next week we will get the deeds on all the properties from the county. It will take about 4 months to get 100% possession. The red light cameras should start in 2 months; we are waiting for approval on a few more lights. We are on the Agenda for the approval from MWRD on the Tinley Creek project. Prices are being calculated on the state police building. Oct. 16th is a breakfast with the Southwest Conference of Mayors.
