

Village to Host Presentation on Infrastructure Projects

Mayor Presta and the Board of Trustees invite you to join them on Tuesday, July 19th at the Civic Center (14025 S. Kostner Avenue) at 7:00 pm to hear a presentation on current and upcoming improvement projects planned for the Village.

These projects include:

- Federally funded pedestrian improvements on Midlothian Turnpike, Cicero Avenue and Pulaski Road;
- Major grant funded projects to alleviate flooding along Tinley Creek: at 135th Street and Central Avenue; and near the Midlothian Country Club;
- An approved plan to bring storm sewers, sidewalks and Crestwood's first bicycle path to 135th Street;
- A large-scale capital plan to replace and improve water mains and sanitary sewers in the Playfield neighborhood;
- A long-range vision for Caesar Park;
- Efforts to acquire grant funds to improve parking at Standard Bank Stadium and the Senior Center;
- Water main construction to improve water pressure and flow on the Village's east side, and;
- An update on the Cal-Sag property developments.

All are welcome to join the Mayor and the Trustees as we forge a path for a stronger and more livable Crestwood in the years to come!
